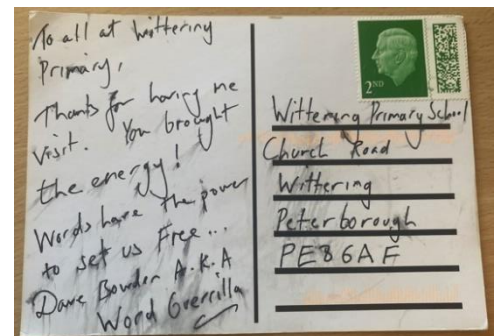
Try Hard, Be Kind, Fly High

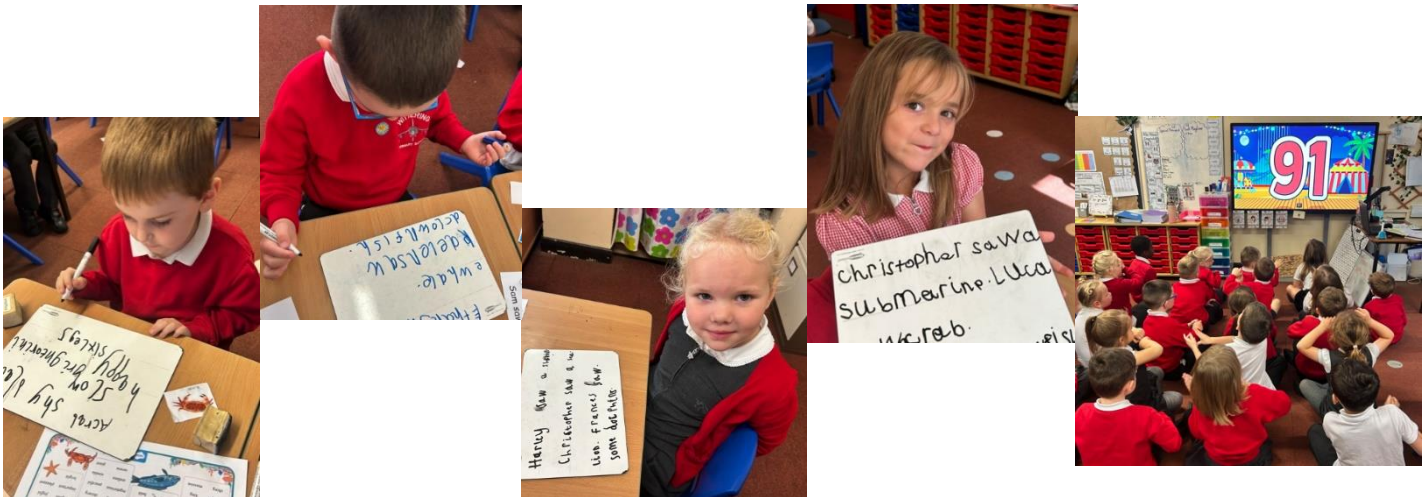
