

Universal Classroom

These aspects help all learners to be successful.

Examples include: sensory-smart classrooms, visual timetables, routines, learning behaviours, metacognition, behaviour management.

Specific Strategies

These strategies are targeted towards specific pupils; they engineer success in accessing learning.

Examples include: pre-teaching, worked examples, use of technology.

Adaptation

Adaptation is informed by prior learning so that all pupils have the building blocks they need to be successful.

Examples include: responding to prior learning, additional scaffolding, more gentle progression in demand to enable content to be learned.

Adaptive Teaching

This happens 'in the moment' as a result of Assessment for Learning within a lesson; this addresses misconceptions immediately and avoids gaps in learning from developing.

Examples include: reteaching new learning, rephrased explanations, more time at the 'we do' stage, in-the-moment worked examples.
