Always Club enjoyed ice lollys at break time today, what a lovely way to cool down and have some fun together!

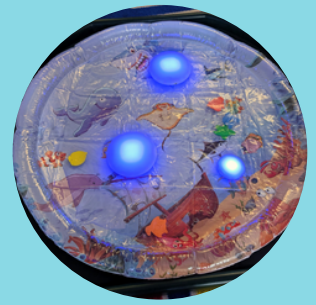

The Families Centre took delivery of some exciting new resources this week which upgraded the play room.

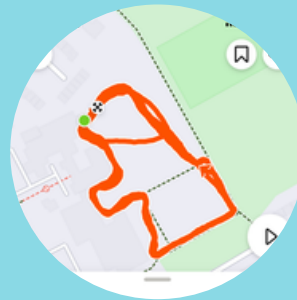
These little ones were enjoying the new additions during the Sensory Chill session on Thursday afternoon.

SOKE Event

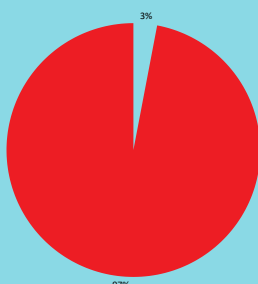

They are a wonderful group of pupils who were a pleasure to spend the morning with.

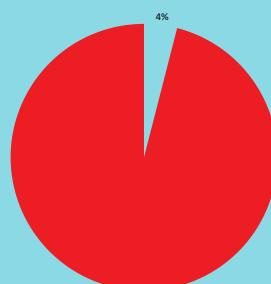


Weekly Attendance

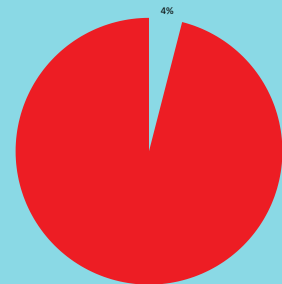
Our attendance across school this week is 91%. The top three year groups for attendance this week were:
